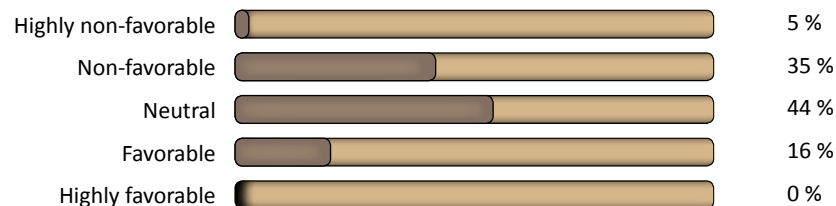
2/ The educational system adequately prepares individuals for Slovakia's labor market needs



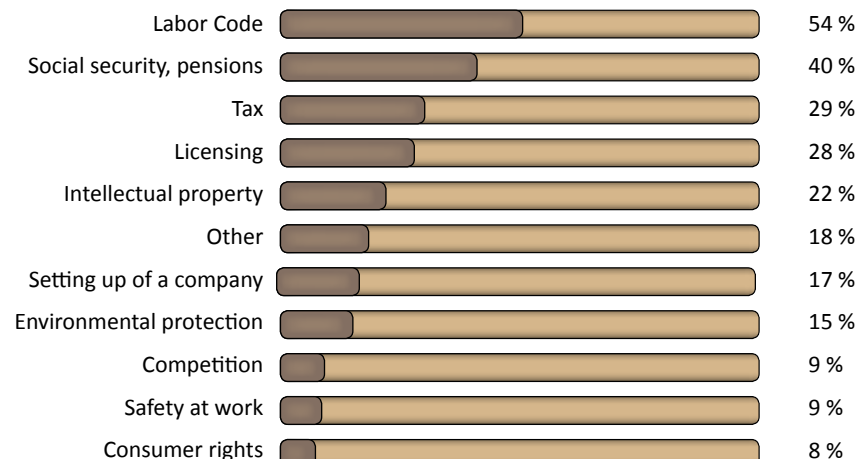
3/ Accessibility to labor with the suitable education level/skills Least available but strategically vital skills

5/ In what areas are legal regulations hindering business?



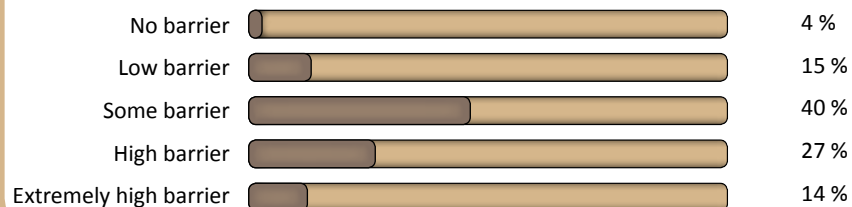

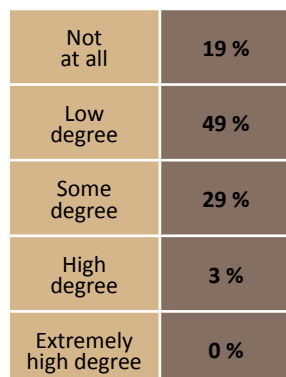

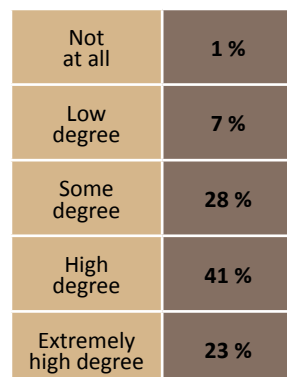

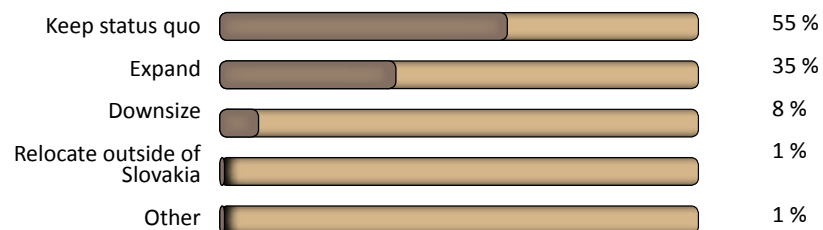

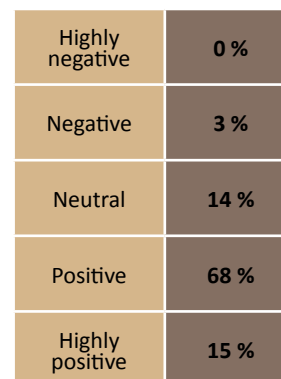
10/ How the economic crisis affected plans for future investments in Slovakia



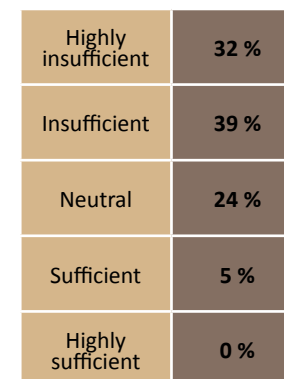
11/ The most likely future scenario for respondents' business in Slovakia:



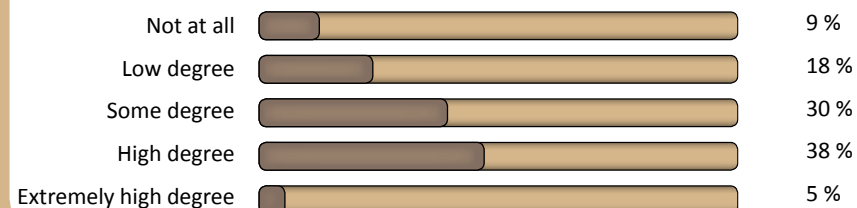
